VALIANCY forwardly placed off the rail, bid three wide nearing the drive, closed determinedly and moved clear late. GALLATIN FOREST never far back, rallied wide and got up for second. PACIFIC TSUNAMI vied for the lead, got clear before the drive, remained clear, then faltered. EMMA'S POSSE unhurried early, showed late interest along the rail. CHARCO devoid speed, improved position wide. SCALDING HOT vied for the lead to nearing the drive, then faltered. PROTEUS showed little. TAURUS THE BULL showed early foot, then weakened. PORT CANAVERAL was always back.
