MACHO AGAIN moved in a bit while well back in the early going, was asked for run nearing the second turn, rallied six wide around the turn, finished determinedly and got up. SECRET GETAWAY set the pace from early on, repulsed IT'S A BIRD'S best in upper stretch, got clear again, then could not hold on. IT'S A BIRD stalked SECRET GETAWAY from early on, bid outside that one around the second turn, then did not have enough late. DRY MARTINI inside to the second turn, eased out to rally, then had no final kick. MY PAL CHARLIE five wide entering the first turn, was steered in to the inside after entering the backstretch, moved up to a contending position around the second turn, then failed to sustain his bid. RICHARD'S KID far back to before the drive, showed late interest mid track. STAR GUITAR four wide around the first turn and wide down the backstretch, moved to the inside nearing the second turn, remained inside for the drive, then had no finish. HONEST MAN reserved early, raced wide down the backstretch, moved up four wide around the second turn, bid entering the drive and then flattened out. WISHFUL TOMCAT forwardly placed for a half, retreated. SLEW'S TIZNOW out footed early, was not a factor. GOOD AND LUCKY forwardly placed for a half, gave way.
