**Footnotes**

CANON MAN set the pace under pressure, lost the lead inside the quarter-pole, dueled gamely with FUTURE COVENANT in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. FUTURE COVENANT pressed the pace on the outside, gained a short lead in upper stretch, battled with CANON MAN on the outside and just missed. BARRACUDA BAY settled towards the rear of the field, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and got up for the show. EVACUATION ROUTE settled at the rear then came under urging, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position. DON'T SHOOT was rated just off the pace while between rivals, dropped back a bit near the half-mile pole, raced three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. HYPE was reserved off the pace, came under urging while two then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. HANDLEMAN was rated just off the pace while between rivals, continued between rivals on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and came up empty. STEWARD HILL tracked the leader on the outside, raced two to three wide on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, came up empty in upper stretch and gave way. LOST CAMPER was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn and dropped out. (Rail at 16 Feet)
