Footnotes

TREASURED UP chose the three path on the first turn, was unhurried near the back while on the outside, shifted five wide early on the far turn, advanced on the outside, swung nine wide into the stretch, chased on the outside while under the whip, drew alongside NORTH BY NORTHLITE in the final sixteenth and narrowly prevailed under good handling. NORTH BY NORTHLITE went to the front, raced two to three wide on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied three wide on the far turn, was allowed to float seven wide into the stretch, came under a drive shortly thereafter, drifted out with a narrow advantage in the final furlong and was caught. ALMIRA FAWN was taken in hand early then rated just off the pace, raced off the rail on the far turn, was asked passing the five-sixteenths pole, chased in upper stretch, loomed a threat into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while able to get the show. FIREHOUSE RED settled on the inside, advanced on the far turn, chased in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but flattened out. TOTHEENDOFTHEEARTH (IRE) went four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, raced four wide on the far turn, was carried eight wide into the stretch, moved in under a drive near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. J J'S CLASSIC was taken in hand early then rated while three wide on the first turn, raced just off the pace, went four wide on the far turn, followed the pacesetter into the stretch in the seven path, despite a gaping opening to the inside, was put to a drive shortly thereafter and came up empty.
