LADYOFTHELILLY'S moved up on the inside of AIDEN'S INDY, bumped hard twice with JESS'S JEWEL leaving the backstretch, raced four then three wide on the turn, pursued the pacesetter while under the whip in upper stretch, gained the lead passing the furlong marker and edged clear under strong urging. INTERCOMPANY LOAN accelerated to the lead, set the pace, raced a bit off the rail on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and was outfinished while clear for the place. MONNIE MARIE was last away, moved up towards the inside, saved ground on the turn, shifted out at the quarter-pole and weakened while clear for the show. PRIVATE FLIGHT bumped with a rival the start, raced towards the rear of the field, went three wide early on the turn, steadied slightly when JESS'S JEWEL dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to one off the rail, moved to the inside at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. PERDIDO'S HOLIDAY bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along towards the rear, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. JESS'S JEWEL tracked the pace, bumped hard twice with LADYOFTHELILLY'S leaving the backstretch, dropped back while three to four wide on the turn and faded. AIDEN'S INDY was urged along on the outside, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced five wide on the turn and faltered.
