Footnotes

PAOLI broke out at the start, settled in third position, ranged up while four then three wide on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. PANCHO PUDDLES broke a bit slow, settled on the inside, rallied on the far turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and was second best. LEAHA'S PRINCESS saved ground on the first turn, shifted out early on the backstretch, was reserved off the pace, moved closer while five then four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and drifted out while weakening but held the show. HONORARY GALLOP settled towards the rear, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, came under the whip at the quarter-pole, moved out in the final furlong and lacked the needed response. ARAGORN'S QUEEN set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. ELLE ATLANTIC raced three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
