PURGENALITY raced inside on the first turn, was reserved at the rear of the field, waited while near the inside on the far turn, was asked while three wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under strong urging. MISTER BERNSTEIN was well rated while setting the pace, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and was outfinished but gamely earned the place. MR. TICKET raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, ranged while four wide on the far turn, took the lead while under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished then just missed the place. RUN RIGHT AT IT was last away, dropped to the inside, was rated just behind the leader, saved ground through the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and came up empty. THIRSTY THURSDAY stalked the leader on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and tired. CHEYENNE PASS raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and dropped out.
