SUPER WAGER settled early, split foes late, closed determinedly and got up in the final stride. OUR HALO clear early, opened up nearing mid stretch and just failed to last. SPOONER devoid speed, rallied late mid track. BOLD BLUFF forward while off the rail, hung. DETECT close up, had no final kick. PALATKA saved ground and could make little impact. ALMATY was always back. CHAPEL OAK between foes, was outrun. FACTOR IN lunged at the break, trailed and was not a threat. SPLENDID STYLE close up for a half, stopped. UNFATHOMABLE showed speed for a half and weakened. CHATEAU DEHERE off the rail, stumbled and fell.
