NO RULES NOW was well placed in fourth position, chased while off the rail on the far turn, moved out once straightened for the drive, rallied under the whip, gained the lead inside the furlong marker, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and moved clear under good handling. THE WOLF IS BACK raced four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid while four then three wide on the far turn, inched clear under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while clear for the place. GEAX WANDO was reserved on the inside, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. PIANO RULES went three to four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear while on the outside, advanced three then two wide on the far turn, drifted out near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. MANCHAC was rank early, raced three wide on the first turn, was rated just behind the leader, engaged that rival while three then two wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, chased THE WOLF IS BACK into the final furlong and gave way. ROCKET KING raced off the rail on the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, came under pressure on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch and capitulated. A MILLION FIELDS broke in and bumped with a rival, settled towards the rear while on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to rally. IDEAL ZARB was bumped at the start, settled towards the rear while off the inside, climbed a bit early on the far turn and failed to threaten. CASTNET KENT was taken back while eager nearing the first turn, raced two to three wide on that turn, was reserved in the middle of the

field, came under urging while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
