Footnotes

WEST OF THE PECOS bumped lightly with WOO WOO KID after the start, was forwardly placed on the outside, went three wide on the turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive, battled with WANNA BE FAMOUS in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. WANNA BE FAMOUS bumped with HESA HUNK at the start, was well placed towards the inside, came three wide into the stretch, chased under a drive, made a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled with the winner in the final furlong, drifted out late and was outfinished while well clear for the place. K T'S GOLDEN YEAR settled off the pace, went four wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased under the whip in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. STARRYWALK was urged along while off the pace, dropped to the inside on the turn and failed to rally. GENTLEMEN JOHNTREAL tracked the pace under a snug hold, was given his cue in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, drew even while between horses at the quarter-pole, lugged in outside the furlong marker, bothered HESA HUNK and gave way. THIRTY ONE ALWAYS broke a bit slow then was taken up, raced at the rear while a bit green, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved further to the outside and failed to threaten. BORDER PLAY brushed with a rival at the start, settled towards the rear, was roused while two to three wide on the far turn and was no factor. HESA HUNK bumped with WANNA BE FAMOUS at the start then was hustled, set the pace on the inside, vied along the rail on the turn, checked sharply while beginning to drop back outside the furlong marker and tired. WOO WOO KID bumped lightly with WEST OF THE PECOS early, settled on the outside, raced five then four wide on the turn and failed to respond. Following a stewards' inquiry, GENTLEMEN JOHNTREAL was disqualified from fifth and placed eighth for interference near the eighth-pole.
