STAKES Colonel Power S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, March 2. \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start.

Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight 122 lbs.

Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since December 16, allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since November 16, allowed 4 lbs.

\$20,000 on the turfsince then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The maximum field size for the Colonel Power Stakes will be determined by rail setting. Preference will be given to horses with the highest total earnings on the turf in 2012-2013. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

Closed Saturday, March 2, 2013, with 22 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.) (Rail at 7 feet).

ICON IKE settled well back in the field, moved in leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, rallied between rivals outside the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then drew clear while drifting out some under strong urging. BILLY TWO HATS settled well off the pace, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, gained ground under a drive and finished willingly for the place. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE reared badly just before the start, was still in the hands of the assistant starter after the gate opened, spotted the field at least seven to eight lengths, raced well behind while off the rail, swung out at the quarter-pole and finished with good energy but lost all chance at the break. CANULETMEDOWNEASY bumped hard with CHINA at the start, settled off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved closer while under a drive but lacked the needed response. COMISKY'S HUMOR dueled on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, lost the lead outside the sixteenth-pole and tired. CHINA bumped hard with CANULETMEDOWNEASY at the start, was well placed behind the dueling leaders, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SUM OF THE PARTS dueled on the inside of COMISKY'S HUMOR while drifting well out in the course, dropped in leaving the backstretch, vied off the rail on the turn and faded. (Rail at 7 Feet)
