FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, March 2. \$400 to enter; \$400

additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000

Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth.

Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since December 16, allowed 2 lbs. \$30,000 on the turf since November 16,

allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 on the turf since then allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing.

The maximum field size for the Happy Ticket Stakes will be determined by rail setting. Preference to horses that have accumulated

the highest total earnings on the turf in 2012-2013. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the

winning owner. Closed Saturday, March 2, 2013, with 28 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over

the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.) (Rail at 7 feet).

Footnotes

EXTRAVAGANZA settled off the pace, was coaxed along while two to three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved out some while chasing the pacesetter, pursued that rival determinedly in the final furlong and got up at the wire. STORM'S PROMISE set the pace while off the rail, was asked just after turning into the stretch, drifted out some inside the furlong marker, led gamely into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. MONONO tracked the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, chased under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the show. CAT LORE settled on the outside, was urged along while five wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong, moved closer while on the outside but lacked the needed kick. SAME CROSS was last away, settled at the back, raced behind a rival near the seven-sixteenths pole, went three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. GOING TO KUKARO stalked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch, pursued the pacesetter between rivals into the final furlong, checked when dropping back a bit between horses at the sixteenth-pole and weakened. CHO CHO CAT settled on the inside while under some urging, was ridden along while saving ground on the turn and failed to rally. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at 7 Feet)
