SWEET MISS AVERY showed good speed, set the pace, lugged out early on the turn, responded well when set down in upper stretch and held under strong urging. MAKE MUSIC was ridden along near the back, raced two then three wide on the turn and finished well but was too late. FLAT OUT FOXY broke in at the start, raced off the pace while urged along, was carried four wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, angled out inside the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. HOLIDAY PEACE was ridden along at the rear, raced three then four wide on the turn and improved position. RAY'S REBEL DEVIL was reluctant to load, raced on the outside while urged along, went three to four wide on the turn and failed to rally. HIGHLY CONFUSED was hustled from the start then urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and lacked the needed response. AIN'T NO TELLIN' raced towards the back of the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. SUCCESSFULPRINCESS chased the pace, was carried four wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail by the five-sixteenths pole, pursued the winner into the stretch and came up empty. JACK'S FLAME was hustled from the start then urged along on the inside, lugged out early on the turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
