### Footnotes

JACK'S WORK moved in while ridden along off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was guided out in upper stretch, rallied to the lead inside the furlong marker then drew clear under strong urging. DIAMOND BLADE showed good speed and set the pace, was challenged while off the rail on the turn, inched clear briefly outside the furlong marker, lost the lead inside that marker and proved no match while clear for the place. FOREST RUN bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, saved ground on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, moved out at the top of the stretch, was switched to a strong left-handed whip, shifted further out near the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. BANDON DUNES tracked the leader on the outside, engaged that rival while three wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and tired then just missed the show. MR. JOHN JOHN was ridden along towards the rear, raced inside early on the turn then came around a rival, drifted out late and failed to threaten while improving position. METAIRIE dropped back while under some urging, raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to rally. SPECIAL DURBEE was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, stumbled near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. CHAMPAGNE PRAYER was bumped on both sides at the start, chased the pace, came three wide into the stretch and tired. DEVIL'S DAWN raced well back in the field, went four wide early on the turn then dropped towards the inside and showed little then jumped a fence after the race and was vanned off. MELTD BUTTER bumped with a rival at the start, lacked early speed, raced three wide on the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and was no factor. (Rail at 25 Feet)
