GOOD AND LUCKY settled off the pace, was urged along on the far turn, moved out then rallied in upper stretch, made a bid passing the furlong marker and proved best under strong urging. UNBRIDLED'S HEART brushed with a rival at the start, set the clear pace on the inside, was asked at the top of the stretch, led into the final furlong but was outfinished while just able to get the place. CHEF ERIC settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn, came around a rival near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch and closed well to just miss the place. CANDIANO bumped with a rival at the start, raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, drifted in near the furlong marker and improved position. UP AND OUT OF SITE raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MR. BRISTOL raced two to three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, was urged along on the far turn and failed to threaten. NECAISE brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the leader, chased on the far turn and weakened. ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. MAXIMUS RULER was a bit fractious in the post parade then reluctant to load, bumped with a rival at the start, raced four wide early on the initial turn then dropped to one off the rail, was well placed down the backstretch, came up empty while inside on the far turn and faltered.
