FONTANNE came in at the start, dropped back when SHE'SABREES fell back early, moved to the outside of that rival, went three then four wide on the turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch and drew away under strong urging. IN THE WAGON broke in the air then ducked out, was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn and narrowly earned the place. MAGGIE SIMON showed early speed then moved out behind OFF THE LEASH, chased that rival while a bit green, went three wide on the turn and proved no match for the winner then just missed the place. SHE'SABREES came away in good order, dropped back early, raced inside on the turn and failed to threaten. WHY IZZY WHY was carried in at the start, raced well back in the field and was no factor. OFF THE LEASH showed good speed then moved clear, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired. NOTTHETIMETOQUIT broke a bit slow then steadied, raced at the rear of the field and trailed.
