SAINT WILL was well placed just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked while behind rivals in upper stretch, angled to the inside near the furlong marker, rallied along the rail and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. FISH tracked the pace on the outside, went four wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and battled determinedly to just miss. TI TOWNSHIP settled at the rear of the field, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved further out once straightened for the drive, rallied on the far outside and closed strongly but also just missed. DIAMOND BLADE bumped lightly with a rival at the start, contested the pace, was asked for his best in upper stretch, vied into the final sixteenth and was outfinished. READY'S ROCKET settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. UNO DUCKSY bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced just off the pace while between rivals, made a bid while three wide on the turn, vied into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished. EVEN settled near the back, raced towards the inside on the turn and failed to rally. ST. ARIAN moved up to contest the pace, dropped back a bit while inside on the turn and gave way.
