CHARGING INDIAN crossed to the inside while out footed to the turn, settled until after entering the drive, moved out to rally, took over outside MATT'S A GIANT inside the final sixteenth and then held on. ROAD SHOW back early, swung out for the drive, gave a big finish but was too late. MYSTERIOUS LEGEND unhurried, found his best stride late. MATT'S A GIANT vied for the lead, got clear around the turn, remained clear for the drive and then faltered late. SANDYS GOLD vied for the lead to mid stretch and then tired. NAVAL COMMAND within striking distance, lacked a finish. EL SLORIDNO close up, had no response. CRAFTY KID was outrun. ZAMNATION was no real threat. COGGINS HILL was always back. FINNBAR'S PROMISE dropped back. ARCHIE MANNING was never dangerous.
