YOGI AND BOO BOO within striking distance, rallied three wide nearing the drive, bid outside SEA THE SOLDIER inside the furlong grounds and prevailed. SEA THE SOLDIER closest to GREY IDE MAN from early on, bid outside that one turning for home, gained the edge between calls, responded when collared and was out kicked. SAY THE WORD inside to the second turn, moved out to rally, came wide in the drive and was late. SCATINEASYCAT back to the drive, showed late interest from the inside. PERSONAL VELOCITY reserved to the second turn, had no response. WAYSTOGEAUX was no real threat. GREY IDE MAN set the pace to the drive, then stopped. CAJUN TOWNSHIP forwardly placed off the rail, faltered. BOSTON MYSTERY raced inside and was not a factor.
