CROWN OF ARAGORN set the pace through sluggish fractions while under a hold, was given free rein on the far turn, kicked clear of WONKA when set down in upper stretch and proved best under strong urging. MUSTANG POWDER was reserved on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, was guided out behind rivals in upper stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. LOOKS PURRRFECT jostled with rivals at the start, raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out then came between rivals in upper stretch and finished willingly but just missed the place. UNCLE PINK was hard held early then reserved on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. WONKA jostled with rivals at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and weakened. WILD ROSSINI was taken back early, raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged near the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to rally then went wrong nearing the wire and was vanned off after the race. LIMO KID settled just off the pace, came under some urging while three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, had the rider lose her whip near the furlong marker and came up empty. KARMA DISTRACTION jostled with a rival at the start, was eager while in tight quarters on the first turn, raced near the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. BIG VINNIE settled towards the rear, was roused on the far turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
