BALTIMORE BOB settled off the pace, moved closer while inside and urged along on the far turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch, rallied to the lead near the furlong marker then inched clear under good handling. PICKAPOCKET lingered well back in the field, moved closer on the far turn, swung six wide at the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the place. LONESOME STREET drifted four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, set the clear pace, had some trouble cornering while three wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in the vicinity of the furlong marker and weakened while just able to save the show. BRENTWOOD BULLET was off two lengths slow, settled off the pace, moved closer while urged along on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, made a bid near the furlong marker but was outfinished then just missed the show. ERNESTO raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, tracked the leader on the outside, dropped back near the half-mile pole, raced inside on the far turn and came up empty. WILDRALLY broke a bit slow, was reserved at the rear of the field, saved ground on the turns and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
