GAYA lagged at the rear of the field while on the inside, came under a left-handed whip on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and closed with a rush to win going away. LOVE DARE raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. JONES ZING contested the pace on the inside, was set down in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to get the show. ACCEPT dropped to the inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, saved ground while behind the leader on the far turn, moved out behind rivals in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. MAGGIES RANSOM settled towards the rear of the field, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. CRISPY settled well back in the field, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. WAHOO BABE raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied into the final furlong and gave way. FUN FILLED broke outward at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, came under urging while three then four wide on the far turn and had nothing left. (Rail at 25 Feet)
