Footnotes

LITTLE EGYPT raced under a tight hold early then was reserved on the inside, moved closer while continuing to save ground on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied alongside CLEAR MARCH, closed well to get the lead late and prevailed under good handling. CLEAR MARCH raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide inside the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the stretch, rallied alongside the winner, closed well into the final sixteenth and earned the place while not quite able to match LITTLE EGYPT. KAZ U CAN went straight to the lead, set the pace on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the show. SKYANGLE raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while near the inside on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch, was put to an all out drive and lacked the needed kick. DAISY AGAIN bumped with a rival at the start, was a bit rank early while in hand then reserved at the back of the field, went four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed late response. SHE WILL ROCK YOU tracked the leader, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then gave way. ELECTRA PALACE settled on the outside, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. ARCHLY bumped with a rival at the start, raced four then three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, moved to four wide into the stretch and came up empty. DREAMS IN RED raced two to three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and showed little. (Rail at 25 Feet)
