Footnotes

MONA LISA (GER) was well placed on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, moved out and was asked at the top of the stretch, made a bid passing the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely with WOODY'S BLUFF in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. WOODY'S BLUFF was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, responded well when asked in upper stretch, battled gamely with MONA LISA in the final furlong and was denied. P. S. I LOVE YOU was reserved off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turns, was asked while four wide into the stretch, came under the whip near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly for the show. POPPY'S LI'L GIRL raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three then four

wide on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed kick. OUR MISS BROOKSIDE was reserved on the inside, saved ground through the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. FLAT CHANCE settled towards the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the turns, was roused in the vicinity of the quarter-pole and failed to rally. HOOKED ON HOPE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, bumped with CAT BELLS at the top of the stretch and also lacked the needed response. TENSAS PALMYRA lagged at the rear of the field, raced three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, moved a bit further out once straightened for the drive and failed to threaten. RHYME ROYAL lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the turns and was no factor. CAT BELLS tracked the pace, raced between rivals on the far turn, bumped with HOOKED ON HOPE at the top of the stretch and gave way. (Rail at 25 Feet)
