MIS PARDNER RULES moved clear early and remained clear throughout. AT FIRST SPEIGHT settled off the rail, came three wide around the turn, closed late. TAISTEAL CULLE close up, lacked the needed finish. COVER PHOTO out footed early, had her rider lose his whip nearing mid stretch, then could make little impact. SOLID LUNAR devoid speed, was no real threat. BETTER THAN SWISS showed little. EVERYBODY LIES showed speed to the drive, then stopped. HIGH KICKING DREAM fractious in the gate before the start, was not a factor and was eased.
