WHY FLY hustled clear early, remained clear for the drive, then was all out to last. MATZ unhurried while outrun, rallied mid track but was too late. MIDNIGHT PASS close up, eased out in the lane and lacked the needed finish. PURE ROCK back to the drive, eased out and passed beaten foes. SAVIANO raced inside and could make little impact. PORT CAPTAIN forwardly placed to the drive, faded. HOUSE ARREST within striking distance, had no response. TIDE RISING raced wide. SOMETHANG COMIN was always outrun. EXECUTIVE CHIEF showed early foot, then retreated.
