CLEVER THIRTEEN bumped with a rival at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled with LEE CITY into the final furlong then inched clear under steady urging. LEE CITY raced inside on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, tracked the leader while on the inside of a rival, chased on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened while able to hold the place. MUFFIN bumped lightly with a rival nearing the first turn, settled near the back of the field, came under urging on the far turn and finished willingly for the show. LADYGOEASY raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went two then three wide on the far turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. CELESTIAL SHOW bumped lightly with a rival nearing the first turn, raced four wide on that turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, had the rider lose his whip outside the sixteenth-pole and failed to rally. I LOVE PICKLES bumped lightly with rivals nearing the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, was unhurried at the rear, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. IM A SALTY BELFAST bumped with a rival at the start, set the clear pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. DAWN'S TRIBUTE was rated off the pace, came under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. CIGAR STARTER was reserved on the inside, saved ground on both turns and also failed to respond.
