Footnotes

SPLENDIFEROUS dropped in during the initial straightaway, settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, drafted behind the pacesetter while inside on the far turn, was blocked behind that rival in upper stretch, rallied along the rail into the final furlong, gained the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and proved best under strong urging. SARGE HUDSON went to the front, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, was collared passing the sixteenth-pole, had the rider lose his whip shortly thereafter and missed. SOUND EFFECT exchanged bumps with SPECIAL ENERGY early, went three wide on the first turn, floated further out entering the backstretch, stalked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader while two to three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and was outfinished while able to get the show. READY TO TAUNT went two then three wide on the first turn, floated further out entering the backstretch, settled off the pace, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, waited while between rivals on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. SPECIAL ENERGY bobbed ever so slightly at the start, exchanged bumps with SOUND EFFECT early then was taken back, lagged at the rear of the field, went two to three wide on the turns and failed to rally. NO SPIN went three then four wide on the first turn, floated wide onto the backstretch, settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, chased four then three wide on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened.
