TREAD moved up between rivals while in hand to take the lead, fought the rider while moving clear approaching the half-mile pole, was given some free rein while off the rail on the turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, battled under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, responded well when switched to a left-handed whip at the eighth-pole, fought back gamely on the inside, regained the lead late and resolutely held off the fast closing runner-up. I THINK SO showed speed and went to the front early, relinquished the lead outside the half-mile pole, lost position while inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied on the outside in the final furlong and closed determinedly to just miss. SILVER STRIKE was taken in hand then reserved under a tight hold while on the outside, advanced leaving the backstretch, raced four then three wide on the turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while well clear for the show. QUIET SUCCESS was grabbed with the left rein at the start, settled towards the inside while under some restraint, was roused while two to three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SAY BAY was away alertly, tracked the pace on the outside, chased while three then two wide on the turn, was corrected off the heels of I THINK SO near the quarter-pole and tired.
