PROPER EMPIRE raced off the rail on the first turn, moved up while eager early on the backstretch, was rated just off the pace, advanced two then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, edged clear under a drive outside the furlong marker and held gamely under strong urging. MOSHAAGIB came out at the start, angled in at the rear, settled on the inside, moved closer late on the backstretch, was urged along while inside on the far turn, shifted out under a drive in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and closed determinedly but just missed. CLASSY AL settled while off the inside, was coaxed along between rivals on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, chased under the whip into the final furlong and finished willingly for the show but lacked the winning kick. BERNSTEINS STAR veered in at the start, went to the front while pulling at the bit, set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. EMPIRE TAKER broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled nicely on the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. KARANOS settled at the back while on the outside, went three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. HESACOYOTE was rank while three to four wide on the first turn, moved up while fighting the rider early on the backstretch, stalked the pace on the outside, dropped back some while four wide on the far turn, floated six wide into the stretch and faltered. (Rail at 15 Feet)
