CHATHAM veered out after the break bumping WHAT A CRACKER, was straightened, vied outside INOMUFF to mid stretch, got clear and then prevailed. GRAEME SIX veered in at the break, was straightened to rail close up from the rail, angled out turning for home, moved out a bit further to rally but was outfinished. INOMUFF vied inside CHATHAM to before mid stretch, got headed and then saved the show. BIENHEUREUX reserved early, came four wide around the turn and then could make little impact. MISS BREW HA HA forwardly placed, had no rally. WHAT A CRACKER bumped by CHATHAM after the break and forced out into MS. FAST SLEW, moved to the inside before the turn, continued inside and passed beaten foes. MS. FAST SLEW bumped after the break by WHAT A CRACKER, was outrun. LADY CORREDOR was no real threat. SHE'S ROUGHIN IT forwardly placed for a half, weakened. JON' JEAN showed little.
