BEN'S GRAND BABE inside to the second turn, moved out while advancing, rallied three wide turning for home and got up in time. REAL QUIET JUDY set the pace from early on, then could not hold on. CHIEF MENA angled to the inside nearing the first turn, continued inside until the second turn, moved out to rally four wide and was gaining late. QUEEN'S MAGIC raced inside to no avail. SATIN ROSE broke through the gate prior to the start, in the race she stalked REAL QUIET JUDY to inside the furlong grounds, then faltered. CLEOME broke through the gate prior to the start, moved to the inside around the first turn, remained a threat to before the drive, then faded. LADY IN THE PULPIT was always outrun. AXIS OF EVIL was never dangerous.
