TERRYHOWIEANDJIMMY between foes to nearing the drive, angled out and got up for the show. WINYAH inside to the drive, got steered out and was outfinished. HIDDEN GLANCE crossed to the inside early, continued inside to before the drive, swung widest and was gaining late. FIFTY FIVE devoid speed, showed late interest. SIR RABBIT vied between foes to mid stretch, then faltered late. COBRADOR raced wide.
