Footnotes

COLD HARD BISQUIT brushed the outside of the gate at the start, went to the front, set the pace on the inside, was asked in upper stretch and just held under strong urging. LAST MUSIC tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the quarter-pole, chased COLD HARD BISQUIT into the final furlong, drew alongside that rival coming to the sixteenth-pole but just missed. LONE STAR TOUR went four then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front, raced off the rail early on the far turn then dropped to the inside, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. SON HONEY was reserved towards the back, went four to five wide on the far turn and improved position. MCGEHEE'S MERCY raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled on the backstretch, was ridden along while off the rail early on the far turn, checked sharply when shut-off by OZZITY at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to the inside in the final furlong and failed to threaten. HARD WORKING DAN floated eight wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide by late on that bend, settled off the pace, moved closer late on the backstretch, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. Z MAN broke a bit slow, floated six wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn and tired. DIXIE FORTY FIVE was taken in hand while eager early, swerved six wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, lingered towards the rear, saved ground while ridden along on the far turn and failed to threaten. OZZITY broke a bit slow, moved up while rank early, swerved three wide into the first turn then dropped to the inside, raced towards the rail on the backstretch, came out and bothered MCGEHEE'S MERCY at the five-sixteenths pole and had nothing left. ALMOST LUCKY was forced seven wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide by late on that bend, lagged at the rear, went two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and was no factor. (Rail at 15 Feet)
