ACHAEMENES went to the front then was taken under a tight hold, raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the clear pace, vied inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead to SNEAKY KITTEN, dueled with that rival in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. SNEAKY KITTEN floated out entering the first turn, raced three wide on that bend, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead in upper stretch, dueled with ACHAEMENES in the final furlong and missed. MAJOR GAIN went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was asked while three wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. AT THE PULPIT went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and lacked the needed response. SCAT ABOUT was taken under a tight hold then reserved while off the rail, raced under heavy restraint while behind horses on the backstretch, was urged along between opponents on the far turn and failed to threaten. FRIENDLY BANTER settled on the inside, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. BAUERS GOT HOURS went five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. (Rail at 15 Feet)
