LASSIE'S LEGACY close up, ranged up outside the leaders, bid three wide and proved best under strong handling. SPLIT THE ARROW reserved while saving ground, eased out approaching the drive, lacked room, angled in to split foes and was late inside the winner. FIDGET in hand early, rallied four wide, gained the edge and did not have enough late. ONEIDA never far back, was steered out five wide in upper stretch and hung. JEWELL OF JEWELS devoid speed, raced between foes and was not a threat. BELONG TO LASSIE vied for the lead and weakened late. ELROSE settled early, made a run five wide around the second turn and flattened out. SUAVE SENTIMENT (IRE) saved ground and was outrun. DISTANT ROAR forced the pace until upper stretch and tired. SACRED GEM was always back. FEDERAL CASE was outrun.
