GET IN DA HOUSE raced three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, chased on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch and inched clear under strong urging. IDEFROMTHEBAYOU was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead near the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to hold the place. VIGILANTE LAW settled off the pace, was roused while three wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. NOWHERE TO HIDE settled off the pace, moved closer while four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. GHOSTWALKING was fractious in the gate, lagged well behind, saved ground on the turns and failed to rally. CHOCTAW BILL was a bit eager early then rated off the pace, came under urging while inside on the far turn and dropped out.
