MONK E SEE raced three wide on the first turn, settled at the back, moved closer midway down the backstretch, went four then five wide on the far turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead just inside the furlong marker then drew clear under steady urging. LADIES LUV OUTLAWS stumbled badly at the start, came away in a complete tangle, moved up while rank to take the lead, swerved six wide into the first turn, dropped to the inside late on the bend, set the pace while under a snug hold, was let out a bit while off the rail on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. BASONE bobbed at the start then came out, raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was reserved off the pace, moved closer midway down the backstretch, was asked while inside on the far turn, moved out while leaning inward in upper stretch, raced alongside of PARRAIN into the final furlong, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and just missed the place. SUMMERSTAR BIRD went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled off the pace, was asked while four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. BIG BLUE SKY was reserved off the pace, moved up in hand midway down the backstretch, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. PARRAIN was hard held while rank early then carried wide into the first turn, dropped to three wide late on that bend, stalked the pace on the outside, was given free rein while three wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and gave way. (Rail at 15 Feet)
