**Footnotes**

MINNIRAHY saved ground on the first turn, was reserved off the inside on the backstretch, went four to five wide on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then pulled clear under strong handling. IRISH CONFIDANT lugged out a bit entering the first turn, was rated off the pace, raced inside on the far turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, lacked room behind horses approaching the furlong marker, altered course sharply to the outside and finished with good energy to grab the place. SLIGEAX BEAU went four wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, went five then four wide on the far turn, chased under the whip in upper stretch, gained a slim lead into the final furlong but was outfinished while able to get the show. TEN TO MIDNIGHT went four wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, chased four then three wide on the far turn, pursued the leader in upper stretch, made a bid entering the final furlong but weakened. BIGANTLERS was restless in the gate, went four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, lugged out a bit leaving the backstretch, raced four wide early on the far turn then dropped to one off the rail, made a bid in the process, battled into the final furlong and tired. ALWAYS BROKE was reserved while off the inside, was asked at the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. PRINCE KADEN raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace through glacial fractions, vied inside on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. DYNABIRD was wrestled back in the early going, raced three wide while under restraint on the first turn, was hard held at the back, was given free rein while three wide on the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 15 Feet)
