APPROVETHISMESSAGE saved ground early on the first turn then came off the rail, was reserved towards the back, raced in the two path on the far turn, drafted off heels approaching the quarter-pole, shifted out at the top of the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to get the lead entering the final furlong and drew clear under strong urging. BAD STUDENT raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through tepid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead before the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. SILVER ROCKET MAN went two then three wide on the first turn, was reserved at the back of the field, raced towards the inside while let out on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, angled out under a drive at the three-sixteenths and safely secured the show. ZANDER ZONE was taken in hand early, went two to three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace, came under urging while off the rail on the far turn, chased into the final furlong and tired. THE THIRD ACE went four wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside with five furlongs to run, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty. INDIAN PEGASUS was rated on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and gave way. MARGARITA BIBB went four then three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and capitulated. (Rail at 20 Feet)
