Footnotes

SANTA tracked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, battled with MARCHING ORDERS and ALUMNI into the final sixteenth then moved clear under steady urging. ALUMNI set the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished but just earned the place. MARCHING ORDERS was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the place. MAAN settled just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. PRIVATE PRAYER was urged along at the rear, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. ONE SURVIVOR settled on the outside, went four wide on the turn, chased in upper stretch and weakened. TWO LEFT SHOES settled between horses, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went three then four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
