Footnotes

MAS GOLD raced towards the front while on the inside, was shuffled back badly leaving the backstretch, regained momentum while inside on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole, moved clear shortly thereafter then held off the fast closing runner-up in a big effort. CLOBBER bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, raced towards the front, lost position while in tight leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied in the final furlong and closed well but was too late. SWAY SPLENDID was ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn, moved to five wide outside the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch, was guided out around the drifting BOY DOG and finished with good energy to garner the show. BOY DOG bumped lightly with rivals at the start, showed some speed, was shuffled back leaving the backstretch, went two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole, came five wide into the stretch, drifted out near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed kick. FORTY CRIMSONS showed speed from the outside, moved clear inside the half-mile pole, drew off while off the rail on the turn, remained clear into the final furlong, was collared near the sixteenth-pole and tired. ELAINES DRAMA was urged along while off the pace, went three then four wide on the turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. TOM AND CHARLIE showed speed then chased the leader, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. MAULED bumped lightly with rivals at the start, steadied in the early going, went four then five wide on the turn, swung eight wide into the stretch and was no factor. CANE SAR was last away, showed no speed, went three to four wide on the turn and was outrun. ALLABOUTTHELADIES bumped lightly with MAULED at the start, showed speed then chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and stopped. WIRE LEO was urged along near the back, climbed while racing greenly near the half-mile pole and showed little.
