### Footnotes

SHADOW ROCK chased the pace, raced inside on the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, gained the lead entering the final furlong and edged clear while a bit green under steady handling. ENGLISH POUND chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, pursued the pacesetter in upper stretch, moved out in the final furlong and finished willingly for the place. DRAMA COACH showed good speed, moved clear nearing the seven-sixteenths pole, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, drifted out significantly in upper stretch, lost the lead entering the final furlong and weakened while well clear for the show. RUSHIN' RUBIETTA raced towards the rear while off the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and improved position. MAYPARK was away alertly, dropped off the pace while under some urging, went three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SMOKIN' HOT raced in the middle of the field, saved ground on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker and also failed to rally. SHAMROCK EDGE dropped back while racing a bit greenly and was no factor. I'M IN TO HAPPY showed good speed then chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and tired. UNBRIDLED CAJUN dropped back at the start, settled on the outside, lugged out leaving the backstretch, raced five then four wide on the turn and failed to respond. CRUACHAN raced well back in the field, went three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and showed little. HEAD-ON VIEW OF START UNAVAILABLE. (Rail at 15 Feet)
