CHAWNA unhurried early, saved ground around the turn, eased out in upper stretch, split foes inside the final furlong, bid inside the leader and drew clear quickly. PLEASANT TREAT trailed until the drive, found her best stride late and closed a gap outside. M J'S MISS out sprinted early, rallied mid track and just missed the place. KENTUCKY KYTHER out from the rail while unhurried, bid four wide nearing the turn, surged clear and then faltered late. PROSPECTOR'S CREEK settled early and showed late interest. TIZ TIPSYP improved position. I'M A TUDOR forwardly placed, faded. FINE SOCIETY showed speed from the rail and weakened. IRISH SISTER showed early speed and tired. SHELOVESTOBOOGIE broke through the gate prior to the start, in the race she saved ground. TODAY'S HEROINE outrun early, was not a factor. MUSIC CONNECTION showed speed for a half and stopped.
