MELDRICK raced four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn, closed well to get the lead near the three-sixteenths pole then drew clear under steady urging. EXCESSIVE ASSAULT raced four then three wide on the first turn, followed the leader down the backstretch, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and just earned the place while no match for the winner. A MILLION FIELDS raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced towards the inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while just missing the place. QUIET TITLE threw his head while very rank and three wide on the first turn, settled a bit on the backstretch, was urged along on the far turn and failed to rally. INDIAN EDDIE was caught five then four wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, came under some urging on the far turn and

improved position. OUR ROCKET MON steadied entering the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. CITY CENTER raced four then three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field and never reached contention. BIG BUFF set the clear pace through solid fractions, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. KNOT FLOYD raced towards the front of the field, saved ground on the turns and came up empty. FOREVER SURE was fractious in the gate, settled towards the inside and also came up empty. SIR MAXWELL settled well off the pace, raced towards the inside on the turns and failed to respond. ELOC broke a bit slow, lagged near the back, went three to four wide on the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
