FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD, ACCREDITED LOUISIANA BRED. No Nomination fee, \$300 to enter, \$300 to start.

Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 since January 25th, allowed 2 lbs. \$25,000 since December 25th, allowed 4 lbs, \$18,000 since then, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest total earnings in 2010-2011. Starters to be named through the entry box at usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 starters. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, March 12, 2011, with 21 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.). KISSIMMEE KYLE showed good speed, contested the pace on the inside, inched clear while inside on the turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch and held under steady handling. CHIEF JAY showed early speed then dropped back, lost position leaving the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole and finished willingly for the place. HUD'S REBEL showed early speed then settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the turn, bumped lightly with FOREIGN PRODUCTION outside the quarter-pole, raced behind the leader while under some urging in upper stretch, moved to the outside near the furlong marker, dropped back inside when KISSIMMEE KYLE came out a bit around the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. CLASSY DEELITES was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, was put to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, chased into the final furlong and weakened. FOREIGN PRODUCTION contested the pace on the outside, chased on the turn, bumped lightly with HUD'S REBEL outside the quarter-pole and steadied a bit then gave way. (Rail at 0 Feet)
