Footnotes

THUNDER AFFAIR raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled near the rail, saved ground on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch and inched clear under strong urging. FRIEND OF INDY quickly crossed over, took the lead, set the pace while off the rail, lost the lead in upper stretch and was outfinished while able to get the place. WILLIST lingered well back in the field, moved out on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. FIRST TO BINGO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and weakened. HIGH HOPES E DAY broke in at the start, settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and lacked the needed response. CYCLONE'S PRAYER broke a bit slow, went five then four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. BANTA went three then two wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, chased on the far turn and came up empty. LAFOURCHE was recalcitrant behind the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, moved up to contest the lead while in hand, tied three to four wide on the far turn and capitulated. CAJUN DUST raced three wide on both turns and was no factor. SLIGEAUX BEAU was always outrun.
