Footnotes

RAJA'S RULE quickly sped clear, dictated terms while inside on the turn, responded well when asked in upper stretch, maintained a clear advantage into the final sixteenth and held for a share of the victory. LITTLE LOLA was bumped hard just after the start then forced into a rival, raced on the outside while ridden along, went five to six wide on the turn, rallied on the outside, closed well in the final furlong, drifted in late and got up at the wire to share the win. SOUTHERN CITY chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and finished willingly for the show. ARTICULATE LADY was bumped hard after the start, raced well off the pace while ridden along, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. SEFA'S PYE veered out at the start then bumped with a rival, was ridden along while off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. DOUBLE DARE YA was ridden along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. BAIE CHATTE was ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. CHOOSE BAILEY chased the pace, raced inside on the turn and tired. AUTUMN CRUX was ridden along on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and also failed to respond. MISS BIDDY bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along towards the rear, went two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. ORO SENORITA was very slow into stride, dropped well behind and was distanced.
