MANCHAC raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, inched closer while three to four wide on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, gained the lead passing the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. ONE SURVIVOR was well rated while setting the pace, came under a drive in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the furlong marker and was outfinished while clear for the place. SHINEMAN saved ground on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, raced four then three wide early on the far turn, dropped to the rail inside the five-sixteenths pole and got up for the show. FOREVERSINGLE went five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, was rated on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked

nearing the quarter-pole and came up empty. KENS KARMA settled off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn but also came up empty. GEAUX WANDO saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, went five wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. A MILLION FIELDS settled towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn and was no factor. IDEMANDRESPECT raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was rated off the pace, raced inside on the far turn and failed to respond. LIME ME was fractious in the gate, went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased on the far turn and tired. CHEF SCOTT settled near the inside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
