Footnotes

CITY NUMBER settled on the inside, moved out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well to get up late. STORM IN THE LAKE chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, edged clear in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. WAR BRIDLE settled just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. SCALDING HOT settled while under some urging, went three wide on the turn and failed to rally. BADGER BARRY was urged along while off the pace, came in near the half-mile pole, went two then three wide on the turn and also failed to rally. RANGER DANGER set the pace, raced near the inside on the turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. HEY RED chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside coming to the quarter-pole and tired. QUAZAR was off two lengths slow, steadied when BADGER BARRY came in near the half-mile pole and failed to threaten. WEATHER WARRIOR raced well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn, drifted six wide into the stretch and was no factor.
